

## F9 V4.x Installation on a Server Running Terminal Services

### Prerequisites:

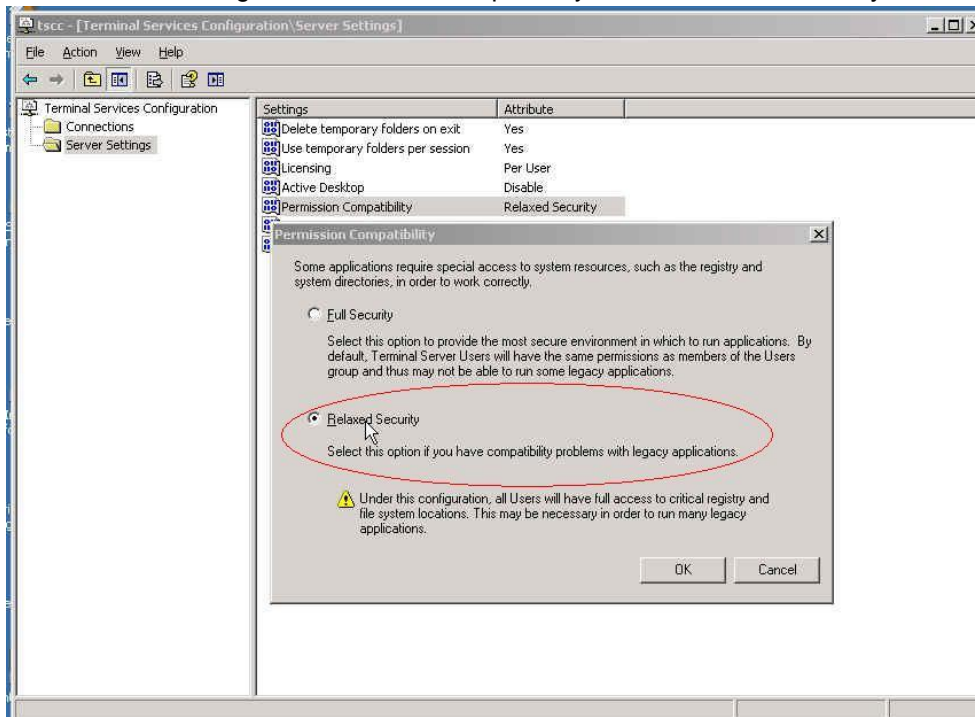
The Terminal Server configuration setting required for F9 is “Relaxed Security”.

To change/check the settings on the Server where F9 is going to be installed follow the next steps:

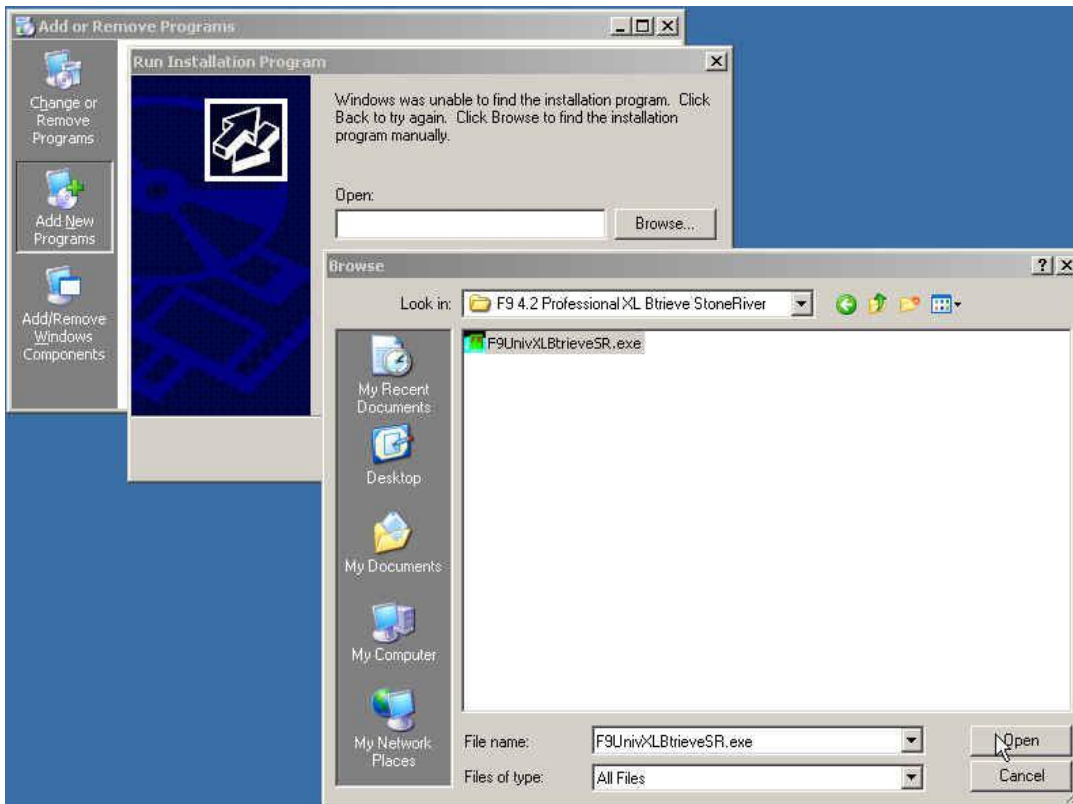
- Launch **Terminal Services Configuration**:



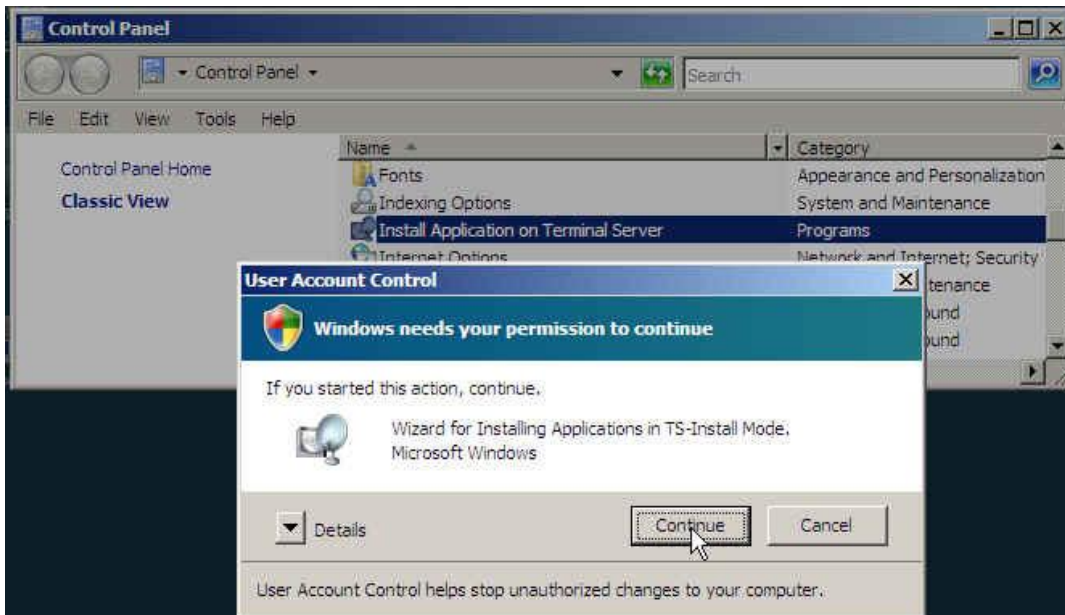
- Under Server Settings-> Permission Compatibility check “Relaxed Security”



- Installing F9 on a TS or Citrix Server has to be done using Add/Remove Programs in Control Panel.\*\*\*



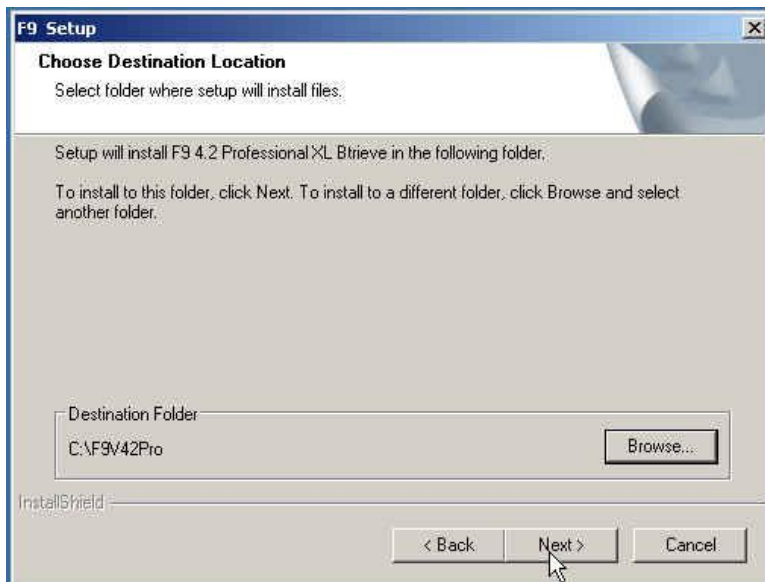
\*\*\* Note for Windows Server 2008, installing applications for Terminal Server has to be done differently using **Install Application on Terminal Server** in Control Panel.



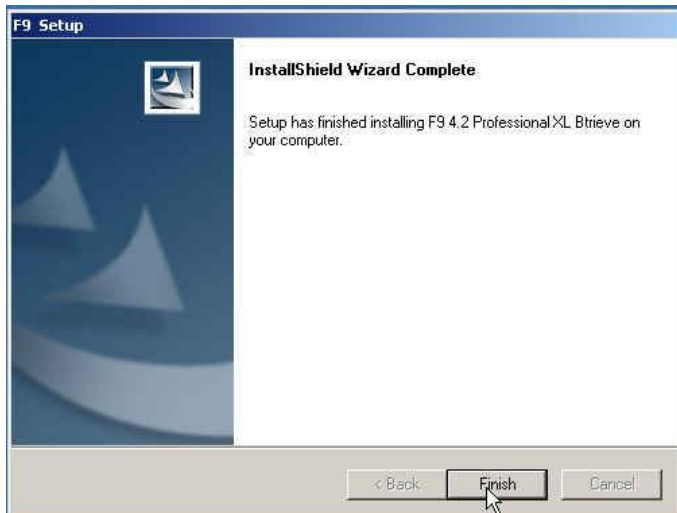
- Windows will display a Security Warning and the user will have to allow the F9 installation program to run.



- Installation folder has to be provided. To choose a different folder than the default provided, click the Browse button. E.g. F9V42Pro



- End of a successful installation.



\*\*\*\*\*After the install has finished, it is important to ensure that:

1. All F9 Users have to have Modify rights to the F9 Installation Folder
